To Our Venerable Brother John Baptist SRE Cardinal Brady Metropolitan Archbishop, Armagh

Thus we ourselves, by name, Venerable Brother of Ours, joyfully, offer to you our Apostolic Blessing, happily extended to the Coadjutor Archbishop, and abundantly to all the faithful and to all those bound to you by the bond of friendship / relationship, at the same time begging your prayers for the effective execution of Our Petrine Office.
