- Cookstown to Dungannon Church of St. Patrick - 9.8 miles

Dungannon to Newtownhamilton

- Church of St. Patrick (Dungannon) to St. Patrick's Cathedral Armagh - 12 miles
- Armagh to Newtownhamilton: Church of St. Michael - 12.4 miles

#### TUESDAY 8TH APRIL

Newtownhamilton to Castlebellingham (Co. Louth)

- Church of St. Michael Newtownhamilton to Silverbridge GAA Club 7.8 miles
- Silverbridge, (via St. Brigid's Church, Kilcurry 4.6 miles) to Church of St. Patrick, Dundalk - 9 miles
- Dundalk to Castlebellingham Post Office
  7.7 miles

#### WEDNESDAY 9TH APRIL

Castlebellingham to Drogheda

- Church of St. Mary Castlebellingham to Church of St. Brigid, Dunleer - 4.9 miles
- Dunleer to Church of St. Peter, Drogheda - 8.8 miles

Enestina (9) lives with her family in a small village in central Malawi. Every day she gets up at 5am and walks a kilometer with her mother to collect water from a small local river. They often make this journey up to six times a day. Because she spends so much time fetching water Enestina can be late for school or too tired to study. What little water they collect is dirty, so she and her family are often ill.

#### ACCESS TO CLEAN WATER TRANSFORMS LIVES.
