Prayer space:

- Small Crib if possible or Picture of a Crib



Let's Look:

• Read the story of the Birth of Jesus from St. Luke's Gospel 2: 1 – 7 "At this time Emperor Augustus ordered a census to be taken throughout the Roman Empire. Everyone, then, went to register himself each to his own hometown. Joseph went from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to the town of Bethlehem in Judea, the birthplace of King David. Joseph went there because he was a descendant of David. He went to register with Mary, who was promised in marriage to him. She was pregnant and while they were in Bethlehem, the time came for her to have her baby. She gave birth to her son, wrapped him in cloths and laid him in a manger – there was no room for them to stay in the inn."

Some questions on the passage of scripture:

- How do you think **Joseph** felt when they got to Bethlehem and there was no room for them in the inn?
- How do you think **Mary** felt when she had her baby?
- If you lived in Bethlehem at that time and saw this young couple without any place to stay what would you have done?

Let's Learn:

• Jesus is a very special baby – he is the Son of God and the Son of Mary

Let's Live:

- During our Christmas holidays this year let us try to help at home so that our families can have a happy time together.
- I can try to do **ONE** nice thing every day at home, e.g., I can empty the dishwasher, or set the table or tidy my bedroom.
